Things to Know

- 65+ GA residents can purchase lifetime licenses via phone, online, mail, or store. If born before July 1, 1952, it is free; if born after, there is a fee.
- Disability, annual honorary veteran one-time, and less than age 64 lifetime licenses **must submit an application**.
- Customers **must** have a valid hunting privilege before they can purchase Big Game.
- Proof of residency is determined by DOL or State ID (if it's not a GA DL or ID, it is considered Nonresident). Temporary GA DOL is not eligible for lifetime, disability, or honorary veteran one-time licenses.
- Nonresidents that own property in GA need to purchase a license to hunt or fish on their property, and must purchase a nonresident license.
