General Information

Smithgall Woods Regional Education Center (SWREC) offers programs for students of all ages in cooperation with the Georgia Department of Natural Resources (GA DNR) Wildlife Resources Division and GA DNR State Parks and Historic Sites Division. All programs are site-specific and are grounded on biologically-sound principles. GA DNR professionals from Parks, Game Management, and community volunteers collaborate to share their personal experiences and expertise on a wide variety of topics. All programs correlate to Georgia's educational standards.

Programming Tips

- Teachers/chaperones are expected to participate and assist with student discipline and safety.
- You may bring your own food/drinks for a picnic lunch on site.
- Restroom facilities are available at, or near, all programming sites.
- Weather appropriate clothing (layered), water, & insect repellent are recommended.

Making Reservations

Programming Fees

- Onsite Programs: \$5/student fee for school groups, homeschool groups, & youth groups. (\$50 minimum)
- Onsite fees may vary for very large groups.
- Group size typically limited to 60.
- Outreach programming is dependent upon mileage from Smithgall:
 - o 0-25 mi.: \$65/program
 - $\circ\quad$ 25- 50 mi.: \$75/ program
 - 50+ mi.: \$75/program + \$40 mileage fee
