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Beach Advisories Lifted on St. Simons Island & Jekyll Island

GLYNN COUNTY, GA – The Glynn County Health Department has lifted the bacteria-related beach water advisories for North Beach at Goulds Inlet (Fifteenth Street to Tenth Street) on St. Simons and Driftwood Beach (Beach KM Marker 1 to Tallu Fish Lane) on Jekyll.

The advisories were issued on March 10, 2020 after routine water quality tests showed a high level of enterococci bacteria which increase the risk of gastrointestinal illness in swimmers.

Subsequent water samples showed that the bacteria levels had dropped below Environmental Protection Agency's recommended limits. Therefore, the advisories have been lifted.
