Learn How the USDA REAP Program Can Help

Suzanne Walker, Coastal Solar Power



This presentation will review the benefits of the Rural Energy for America (REAP) program offered by the USDA. Property Business Owners in Brunswick and parts of Glynn County are eligible to apply. There are grants and loan guarantees available to rural small businesses. These can be used to help fund renewable energy systems and energy efficiency upgrades. We will discuss how the REAP can help you, what funding is available, the requirements necessary to apply, any limitations and how to get started.

The goal of the USDA is to help support energy efficiencies and increase the use of renewable energy in rural businesses and agricultural communities. Coastal Solar has been successful in helping commercial businesses and agricultural producers recoup and save almost \$400,000.00 in project costs associated with solar power installations.
