Re: Letter of Permission (LOP), Georgia Department of Natural Resources Coastal Resources Division (GA DNR CRD) 2018 Beach Week, Activities within the State's Shore Protection Act (SPA) Jurisdiction, South Beach Parking Lot, Tybee Island, Chatham County, Georgia.

Dear Ms. Kline:

This letter is in response to your request dated May 11, 2018 for the GA DNR CRD 2018 Beach Week Public Outreach Event in The Strand parking lot adjacent to the Tybee Pier and Pavilion on Tybee Island, GA. This one-day event in the State's Shore Protection Act (SPA) Jurisdiction is scheduled for Tuesday, June 28, 2018 from 9:00 am - 3:30 pm.

As proposed, this outreach event on Tybee Island includes the placement of six (6) 10ft. x 10ft. tents, as depicted in the plans, on the paved parking area on Tuesday, June 28, 2018. Additionally, the GA DNR CRD Mobile Education Unit will be on display during the event. All tents and displays will be removed no later than June 28, 2018. No impacts to the sand sharing system are proposed, and access to the beach is available to the public at existing crossovers along The Strand.

The Department authorizes the temporary installation of the proposed amenities as depicted in the attached location map, provided all Best Management Practices (BMPs) will be used to prevent any additional impacts at the site and to protect jurisdictional shore areas.

This LOP is not meant to exempt the above referenced activity from future environmental laws. **No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas.** Any incidental impacts associated with this project must be rectified by fully restoring areas to their pre-construction topographic and vegetative states.

This LOP is valid for the above referenced project. Any change in the use, location, dimensions, or configuration of the approved project, without prior notification and approval from this office, could result in the revocation of this permission and in the required removal of the materials and related structures. This project must comply with all other Federal, State, and local statutes, ordinances and regulations.

The Georgia Department of Natural Resources is seeking authorization to hold its annual Beach Week Event on Tybee Island, Georgia on Thursday, June 28th from 9:00 am to 3:30 pm (including setup/breakdown). The event will be on the paved parking lot in front of the Tybee Island Marine Science Center located at 1509 Strand Street, Tybee Island. The event will comprise of the Coastal Resources Division Mobile Education Unit (Truck and Trailer) and six tents for education partners. The event will showcase activities, information and materials covering a wide array of subjects including beach water quality, sand dollar stewardship, and important marine fisheries.

There will not be any disturbance of any vegetation or the sand sharing system as the event area is restricted to only the pavement area.
