Jekyll Clam Creek Beach Advisory Lifted

GLYNN COUNTY, GA – The Glynn County Health Department has lifted the advisory for Clam Creek Beach (from Clam Creek to the old North picnic area) on Jekyll Island.

The advisory was issued on September 28, 2011, after routine water quality tests showed a high level of enterococci bacteria which increase the risk of gastrointestinal illness in swimmers.

Subsequent water samples taken showed that the bacteria levels had dropped below Environmental Protection Agency's recommended limits. Therefore, the advisory has been lifted.
