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### **Beach Advisories Lifted for Three St. Simons Beaches**

**GLYNN COUNTY, GA** – The Glynn County Health Department has lifted advisories for East Beach to the old Coast Guard station (from 10<sup>th</sup> Street to Driftwood Drive); 5<sup>th</sup> Street Crossover Beach (from Cedar Street to 9<sup>th</sup> Street); and South Beach at the lighthouse (from 9<sup>th</sup> Street to the pier) on St. Simons Island.

The advisories were issued on October 30, 2015 after routine water quality tests showed a high level of enterococci bacteria which increase the risk of gastrointestinal illness in swimmers.

Subsequent samples show that bacteria levels are now within acceptable limits; therefore the advisories have been lifted.
