

Harvest Reporting – Game Check

The 2023 spring turkey season was the second season under the new statewide turkey regulations. As expected, total reported harvest remained slightly lower than totals prior to the regulation changes on both public and private lands. However, the average daily harvest was higher than previous years, suggesting a successful season.





Wildlife Management Area Harvest

The 2023 season produced a slight harvest bump compared to 2022 but was still down from previous seasons as the second year under adjusted regulations. WMA hunters harvested 707 gobblers, up 27% from 2022's total harvest. Jakes comprised 10% of the WMA harvest. Overall, hunters had a success rate of 5.0% on wildlife management areas in Georgia.
