SUBJECT: NOTICE AND SYNOPSIS OF PROPOSED RULE MAKING

Notice is hereby given that since O.C.G.A. § 12-3-82.1 has been repealed, the Board of Natural Resources proposes to repeal Rule 391-5-9-.08. Since O.C.G.A. § 12-3-82.1 has been repealed, effective January 1, 2008, there is no permit procedure for deadhead logging. Thus, there is not a need for a rule regarding permitting and compensation for deadhead logs.

SYNOPSIS AND MAIN FEATURES

Rule 394-5-9-.08 needs to be repealed in its entirely. It needs to be repealed because Georgia had a permit procedure in place exclusively applicable to the removal of deadhead logs. However, the General Assembly repealed the permit procedure, O.C.G.A. § 12-3-82.1, effective January 1, 2008. Since there is no statutory basis for deadhead logging, Rule 394-5-9-.08 likewise needs to be repealed.
