Charlie's Trackers Camp (ages 6-8) \$150

June 5-9, Brooke Ager Discovery Area Day camp, 9:00 am – 4:00 pm daily

Inspiring a love of nature and the outdoors, Charlie's Trackers camp opens the door to a lifetime of adventure and fun through live animal encounters, games, and crafts. During this camp, campers will work towards becoming a CEWC Junior Ranger, a program started in Georgia by Mr. Elliott.



Gone Fishin' Camp (ages 11-14) \$275

June 12-16, Charlie Elliott Conference Center Overnight camp, Monday 9:00 am - Friday 1:00 pm

While the parents are away the kids will fish and play all day! This camp is designed for the young angler to learn fishing regulations, and master knot tying, casting, and retrieval of multiple fish species. We will also dive into fish habitat, biology, and management, and our week will culminate in a fishing tournament!

Wildlife Rangers Camp (ages 8-10) \$150

Shooting Sports Camp (ages 12-16) \$275

July 10-14, Charlie Elliott Conference Center

Overnight camp, Monday 9:00 am - Friday 1:00 pm Shooting Sports Camp will get participants started on the path to becoming a safe, responsible shooter by learning the basic rules of gun safety and proper handling of rifles, shotguns, and archery equipment. Safety will be emphasized, as well as learning how to safely clean, maintain, and store firearms. An opportunity to demonstrate their new skills will round out the week.

Adventures in Conservation Education (ACE) (Rising 6th-8th graders) \$175

July 17-21 Charlie Elliott Conference Center and Amicalola Falls State Park

Overnight Camp Monday 9:00 am - Friday 1:00 pm ACE is a unique camp for middle school students focusing on wildlife conservation. Participants will spend five days learning about Georgia wildlife via hands-on activities and day trips in the north Georgia Mountains. Campers will explore the Blue Ridge and Cumberland Plateau ecoregions by snorkeling in the Amicalola River, discussing about black bear research, visiting a fish hatchery, and caving for endemic salamanders and bats. Thanks to a grant from The Environmental Resources Network, the cost of this camp is only \$175 per person.
