The Outdoor Discovery School (TODS) is a multidisciplinary overnight environmental education experience for grades 4th - 12th offered September – April. The program includes options for courses spanning from several ecology-related disciplines to outdoor skills and recreation and nighttime activities. We offer 2 day, 1 night programs for the cost of \$95 per student or 3 day, 2 night programs for \$150 per student with a minimum of 20 students and maximum of 60 students per group. Students and chaperones are housed in Charlie Elliott Wildlife Center's (CEWCs) Lodge and eat at the Dining Hall during their stay. Daytime Courses Offered:

CHANGES AROUND US:

Ever wonder what goes on as a tree is decaying? Students will dissect an entire microhabitat of a rotten log where will investigate microorganisms and macroinvertebrates. We'll also look at what happens in an environment that is constantly under change as we hike one of CEWC's trails looking at the forest ecosystem. GEOLOGY ROCKS!:

Experience the rock cycle as we hike along CEWC's Granite Rock Outcrop Trail to explore one of Piedmont's most interesting geologic features. GSE Science Standards addressed: S5E1a; S5E1b; S6E5c; S6E5e; S6E5h; SEC3b; SEC3d; SES3a; SG2c; SG5a

SKINS, SCALES, AND SKULLS:

Explore the science behind animal classification and identification of mammals, reptiles, and birds through skins, skulls, and animal encounters. GSE Science Standards addressed:

THE INCREDIBLE WATER CYCLE:

What happens to water when it reaches the clouds or the soil? Students will explore the life of a water droplet and see how water moves throughout Georgia's ecosystems. We will also introduce vocabulary relating to water with nature journaling before heading off on a hike to see the water cycle in action around CEWC. WHAT'S IN THE WATER:

(offered September to October and March to May): A pond investigation provides the perfect opportunity to demonstrate the connections and food webs within an ecosystem. By utilizing nets and field guides, students will gain observation skills and discover the adaptations of some amazing aquatic creatures and what they have to say about the water quality of that watershed.
