Delayed Harvest Proposal

1. Designate two new streams as Delayed Harvest.

2. Change the dates of the Delayed Harvest Season.


3. Remove size limits for trout in Waters Creek.

Designate Two New Streams as Delayed Harvest

- 1. Waters Creek (Lumpkin County)
- 2. Raccoon Creek (Paulding County)

Our Rationale: To expand the Delayed Harvest program.

Proposed Delayed Harvest Trout Streams



Change the Dates of the Delayed Harvest Season

Opening Date: Change from November 1 to October 15.

Our Rationale:

- ✓ Provide more angling opportunities during leaf season.
- ✓ Reduce hatchery inventory during the stressful late-summer and fall water quality periods.



Change the Dates of the Delayed Harvest Season


Closing Date: Change from May 14 to April 14.

Our Rationale:

- Reduce the density of trout in the stream to a more sustainable level, especially in streams that can warm early (ex: Morgan Falls DH).
- ✓ Benefit harvest-oriented trout anglers, which make up 77% of trout anglers.



Temperature Effects on Delayed Harvest



Warm temps in late-winter and early-spring coupled with low flows make for challenging fishing conditions in the Morgan Falls DH section. (2016, 2017, 2019)

Water Temperature Trends in the Chattahoochee DH during May

Year	First Day in May > 62°F	No. Fishing Days > 62°F	Peak Temperature before May 14
2016	May 8	10	69
2017	May 1	30	77

Change the Size Limits on Waters Creek

Current Regulation

- 8 fish creel limit
- No tackle restrictions
- Minimum size limit for:
 - Brook Trout (18-inches)
 - Rainbow Trout (22-inches)
 - Brown Trout (22-inches)

Proposed Regulation:

No size limit.


Our Rationale: To allow harvest of stocked fish after the DH season.

Current Status of Waters Creek Trout Fishery

• Not managed for trophy trout for past 20+ years.

• Fishing pressure has declined over the years.

• No trophy-sized trout in the population.



Chattooga River Delayed Harvest Regulation

- Some confusion among respondents about the Chattooga River DH.
- Clarification is needed to indicate that the Chattooga River DH section will be exempt from the proposed regulation change.

• Our Rationale:

- ✓SC-DNR is responsible for stocking the DH section.
- ✓SC-DNR's regulations are set by the state legislature.

Public Feedback on Delayed Harvest Proposal

Proposal	Public Support	Public Opposition	Comments
Total Proposal	59%	41%	
Add Two New Streams (Waters & Raccoon creeks)	96%	4%	16% wanted us to add more than two streams
Change Opening Date to October 15 th	96%	4%	
Change Closing Date to April 14th	71%	29%	Concerned about missing the 'best fishing' of the year.
Remove Waters Creek Size Limits	81%	19%	Concerned about losing the trophy trout population.
