Re: Letter of Permission (LOP) and Revocable License (RL) for Maintenance of a Private Dock, Lots 358A & 359A, Horsepen Creek, Chatham County, Georgia. (GPS: 31.99814°N/-80.85328°W)

Dear Mr. & Mr. Elsby:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request for the maintenance of a private dock that is not exempt from the Coastal Marshlands Protection Act (CMPA) due to the structure being attached to an upland parcel not suitable for a detached single-family residence pursuant to O.C.G.A § 12-5-295(7)(B). The structure was constructed prior to CMPA permitting requirements. The existing dock consists of a 6ft. x 30ft. walkway extending from the upland to a 7ft. x 10ft. fixed deck with a 10ft. x 13ft. covered fixed deck on the seaward side. Currently, a ramp extends seaward from the fixed deck to an unserviceable floating dock.

The proposal consists of replacing the walkway with handrails, re-stringing the deck platform, and adding hurricane clips. The unserviceable ramp and floating dock will be removed prior to completing the project. Re-construction of the previously existing floating dock, or any other modifications to existing configuration or footprint will require a CMPA Permit. The project will begin no sooner than 15 days after the date on this letter and be completed within 6 months of this letter's issuance.

The Department authorizes the maintenance of the existing private recreational dock as depicted in the attached description and drawings. No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed in, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. All material removed must be disposed of at an appropriate upland disposal area. Any visible alterations in marsh topography will be restored immediately using low-impact hand tools. Any damage to the marsh vegetation that has not recovered naturally during the next growing season will be repaired by a method acceptable to the Department.

This authorization does not relieve you from obtaining any other required federal, state, or local permits. Tidal water bottoms and marshlands of coastal Georgia are public trust lands controlled by the State, except for such lands where a validated Crown Grant or State Grant exists.
