Re: Letter of Permission (LOP) Replacement of "No Wake" Signs in Coastal Marshlands Protection Act Jurisdiction, Skidaway River, Chatham County, Georgia.

Dear Mr. Mascolo:

This Letter of Permission (LOP) is in response to your request dated November 20, 2019 for the replacement of four (4) "No Wake" signs on the Skidaway River that were previously authorized by RLS19940042. The signs are located between the University of Georgia Marine Extension and the northern extent of Modena Island, in the locations provided in the Description and Drawings. Each location consists of two (2) pilings which support a 4ft. x 8ft. "No Wake" sign. The project will begin no sooner than 15 days after the date on this letter and be completed within 6 months of this letter's issuance.

The Department authorizes the replacement of the four (4) "No Wake" signs and associated pilings as depicted in the attached description and drawings. No unauthorized equipment, materials, or debris may be placed in, disposed of, or stored in jurisdictional areas. All material removed must be disposed of at an appropriate upland disposal area. Any visible alterations in marsh topography will be restored immediately using low-impact hand tools. Any damage to the marsh vegetation that has not recovered naturally during the next growing season will be repaired by a method acceptable to the Department.

This authorization does not relieve you from obtaining any other required federal, state, or local permits. Tidal water bottoms and marshlands of coastal Georgia are public trust lands controlled by the State, except for such lands where a validated Crown Grant or State Grant exists. 

NE Sector (Between Modena and Dutch close to Dutch) (N 32 00.365, W 081 01.216)





Dear Ms. Schmidt:

I refer to your correspondence of May 4, 1994, furnishing us additional information/location maps for four "no-wake" signs in the marshes adjacent to the Skidaway River, at your facilities on Skidaway Island, in Chatham County, Georgia. The initial request to install these "no-wake" signs was submitted by Mr. Jay R. Calkins of the Marine Extension Service on November 9, 1989. Based on the location map you furnished, the signs are located at the following latitudes and longitudes, respectively: 31°59'35" north & 81°01'15" west; 31°59'29" north & 81°01'10" west; 31°59'18" north & 81°01'35" west; and 31°59'36" north & 81°01'37" west (map enclosed).

The wetlands at the site are waters of the United States and are therefore within the jurisdiction of Section 404 of the Clean Water Act (CWA) (33 U.S.C. 1344). The placement of dredged or fill material into any waterways and/or their adjacent wetlands including material redeposited during mechanized land clearing or excavation of those wetlands would require prior Department of the Army Authorization. In addition, the Skidaway River is also classified as a Navigable Water of the United States, and as such, it is also subject to Section 10 of the Rivers and Harbors Act of 1899 (Section 10) (33 U.S.C. 403). The placement of any structures and/or fills, and the performance of any excavation in Navigable Waters of the United States would require authorization pursuant to Section 10. The "no-wake" signs referenced herein would be considered a structure and would require Section 10 authorization.

Based on our review of the information you furnished, I have determined that the referenced "no-wake" signs are authorized by Nationwide Permit 1, found at 33 CFR 330, Appendix A (B), as published in the Federal Register, Volume 56, Number 226, on November 22, 1991, pursuant to Section 10. I am also enclosing a copy of this Federal Register as information. This Nationwide Permit pertains to the placement of aids to navigation and regulatory markers which are approved by and installed in accordance with the United States Coast Guard, provided that all conditions are met.

It is the policy of the Secretary of the Army and the Chief of Engineers that the regulation of Vessel speed should be handled by local municipalities or counties involved. The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, by authorizing these "no-wake" signs under the Nationwide Permit referenced above, assumes no responsibility for regulating or enforcing these zones. It is requested that you contact the U.S. Coast Guard, Seventh Coast Guard District in Miami, Florida, at the address indicated below, for a determination of their requirements for the "no-wake" signs.
