Wormsloe is a unique historic site, dedicated to protecting
the fortified home of one of Georgia's earliest colonial settlers.

What to expect: We welcome you and your group to learn about the establishment of Georgia as a colony. Our small museum, filled with artifacts and exhibits, is available for your group to explore. Our interpreters lead engaging walking tours to the ruins of Noble Jones' 1736 fortified home, his gravesite, and a Native American shell midden.

Amenities: Gift shop, restrooms, and a picnic area are also available. While there is no food to purchase on site, there are 20 picnic tables available on a first come, first served basis. Your group is responsible to dispose of any waste in the bins provided.

Mobility assistance: Golf carts (operated by staff) are available upon request for any visitors unable to walk the flat, rooted, natural-surface trails. *Please notify our staff of any mobility assistance needs in advance so we can best serve you.*

Please allow a minimum of 1 hour and 30 minutes for your group program. Times vary according to group size. Large groups should plan to divide into smaller groups of 25-30 visitors. Please determine smaller groups ahead of time to get the most out of your experience. Programming is subject to change if group arrives late.

Group Rates for Admission:

Adults: \$9.75 / **Seniors (62+):** \$9.00 / **Youths:** \$5.25

Please note: Group rates are available for groups of 15 visitors minimum and must be paid in a single transaction.

<u>Discovering Wormsloe:</u> This standard experience includes a guided tour to the historical tabby ruins, gravesite of Noble Jones, shell midden, and marsh. Access to museum and gift shop. No additional cost.

Customize Your Visit:

- 1. <u>Colonial Life Experience:</u> This option adds a tour of the simulated Colonial Life Area, including an early blacksmith forge and a wattle & daub (simple construction) home. *Add \$1.00 per visitor*.
- 2. Recreation Experiences (Choose one option):

Option A. <u>Colonial Cricket Experience</u>: Recommended for fourth grade or older. This option adds a fun, interactive game of cricket, Georgia's first athletic sport! Students will learn a simplified version of the rules and play the game, all the while gaining exposure to colonial ways of recreation and leisure activities.

Option B. <u>Colonial Games Experience:</u> Recommended for students of all ages. Games such as Double Ball, Graces, Nine-Pins and more are available for your group to play.
