Feral hogs and coyotes may be taken during any small game or big game season with the appropriate lawful weapons. ² Only small game weapons may be used for small game and furbearer seasons. ¹ Only those species that are open by statewide season are allowed to be hunted during small game and furbearer dates on a WMA. The same is the case for migratory birds.

² This language is for the county's understanding. Since it is covered in general WMA regulations it doesn't necessarily need to be in the Board official regulations.

³ By general WMA regulation, camping on WMA's is only in designated areas, unless otherwise noted. Therefore, camping would not be allowed on Gaither WMA unless we specifically designated such camping areas. Hunters may choose to camp at nearby Clybel WMA or perhaps Factory Shoals Park.
