

NASP® Region Tournament Host Questionnaire

In an effort to gather information used to evaluate potential venues that could serve as hosts for future NASP® regional tournaments, we would like to ask that any school that is interested in hosting a regional tournament for 2018 and beyond complete this questionnaire and return it to Jennifer Pittman on or before April 1, 2017.

The basic requirements for a school to serve as a regional tournament host are:

1. Adhere to all NASP® State Tournament Rules and requirements
2. Set up and preparation for the tournament.
 - a. Hanging curtains, setting targets, laying down the safety lines, laying down shooting lanes. All set up must follow the state standard.
3. Have a dedicated range safety officer using whistle commands and verbal commands.
4. Have a minimum of four range safety officers at the shooting line during each flight.
5. Provide a location outside of the gym to use as a scoring room.
6. Provide at least one person to assist with scoring. These duties will include gathering scorecards and delivering to the scoring room and posting scores every flight.
7. Provide internet access for use during the tournament at the scoring room.
8. The following awards will be provided by the DNR at each regional tournament:
 - a) 1st place team trophy/plaque for each division winner (elementary, middle and high)
 - b) High overall individual archerAdditional awards are at the discretion of the host.
9. Have facilities that are capable of accommodating a minimum of 40 archers per flight (20 target set-up).
10. Agree to accommodate at least 10 teams, with a maximum of 15.
11. Pay a processing fee of \$1.00 per scorecard processed to NASP® Inc. within two weeks of completed tournament
