All equipment and bait will be provided. Food and drink will not be provided. Campers will need to bring their own lunch, snacks, and water bottle. Due to limited space, pre-registration is required by May 31st for session 1, June 15<sup>th</sup> for session 2, and July 12<sup>th</sup> for session 3.
