Home School Program at Charlie Elliott Wildlife Center

We are happy to continue our monthly home school curriculum program this school year! The center's forests, lakes, and streams provide an excellent setting for outdoor learning. The indoor classrooms and live animals enhance the experience by providing up-close wildlife encounters.

The drop-off program is designed for the home-schooled student, emphasizing peer cooperation along with individual exploration. Each program covers a different topic, but all programs include hands-on learning, self-discovery, and outdoor fun. Through hikes, experiments, games, and investigation, we will uncover the secrets of Georgia's wildlife and habitats.

Age and Group Size: The program is designed for 3rd – 7th grade students. The students sometimes will be divided into two age groups, 3-4th grade and 5th – 7th.

Time: 9:30am – 1:30 pm (Students bring their own lunch.)

Location: Charlie Elliott Wildlife Center's Brooke Ager Discovery Area

Cost: \$70 per student for the academic year

Dates: The program takes place the 3rd Friday of each month from October to April. We are now offering a second session that meets every 3rd Thursday from October-April.

Registration: **August 23 & 24, 2018**

Registration will take place at the **CEWC Visitor Center located at 543 Elliott Trail, Mansfield, Georgia**. Come early, as space fills quickly. Bring immunization records or a vaccine affidavit to go with the registration paperwork. We will max out at 20 for both programs. We need a minimum of 10 kids to make either the Thursday or Friday sessions occur. Once registered, parents will receive a schedule, packing list, and first look into our homeschool field days for the academic year.
