## Wildlife and Other Wonders Outdoors



Wildlife and Other Wonders (W.O.W.) Outdoors program is an opportunity for our guests to build a custom program that best suits the needs of their group, club, or company. With a wide variety of outdoor opportunities available within the 6,400 acre Clybel Wildlife Management Area, we will work with you to craft a perfect and unforgettable experience. A session of W.O.W. Outdoors is designed for groups of 10 or more with participants ages 11+ and includes three of the following programs.

### **CANOING (SELF-GUIDED)**

\$5 per person

Rent a canoe and paddle around Lake Margery, one of our largest lakes on the Clybel Wildlife Management Area.

### **CANOING (GUIDED)**

\$10 per person

Join a naturalist on the water as we paddle around Lake Margery and explore the natural history of area and ecology of the lake.

### **ARCHERY**

\$10 per person

Nock an arrow and hit the bullseye with basic archery lessons. With compound bows, staff will train you on safety and archery basics. You can choose to use static, 3-D or moving targets.

### **FIREARMS**

\$15 per person


Give it a shot at the Charlie Elliott Wildlife Center shooting range. Staff will provide safety and instruction as you utilize our firearms. Choose between shotgun, rifle, handgun, or muzzleloaders.

### **FISHING**

\$5 per person

Grab a rod and reel and fish at Clubhouse Lake for bass, bream, or catfish. Staff will provide equipment and bait. Catch and release only. Participants 16 and older are required to have a Georgia fishing license which can be purchased upon arrival for program.

### **TEAM BUILDING / LOW CHALLENGE COURSE**

**\$15 per person**

The low challenge course is an excellent choice for groups that wish to build teamwork and unity among their participants. Concepts include communication, trust, cooperation, encouragement, and goal setting.

### **OUTDOOR SKILLS**

**\$15 per person**

Hone your skills in outdoor recreation. Staff will lead hands-on demonstrations to improve your outdoor knowledge in content areas such as using a compass, fire building, shelter building, and wild edibles. (limit of 3 skills)

### **WILDLIFE PRESENTATION**

**\$40 flat rate fee for groups**

Get up close and personal with some of Georgia's native wildlife. Using live animal as visual aids, a naturalist will discuss conservation topics and natural history.

#### **DRIVING TOUR OF CEWC**

Get a caravan of cars ready as we drive throughout the property and tour of some of the historical and natural sights found at our WMA.

Experience the life of Charlie Elliott as our staff guides you through our Visitors Center Museum and narrate the accomplishments of the man and conservationist after whom this place is named.

#### **INTERPRETIVE HIKES**

Go take a hike on one of our educational trails as a naturalist gives fun facts about the flora, fauna, and human history of Charlie Elliott Wildlife Center.

#### **CHARLIE ELLIOTT ASTRONOMY**

Observe the stars and planets with the Charlie Elliott Astronomy Club the 3rd Saturday of the month. Groups of 15 or more are encouraged to request a separate outreach event with Charlie Elliott Astronomy Club.
