Create a Go Outdoors Georgia account profile at <https://www.gooutdoorsgeorgia.com/> or by calling 1-800-366-2661. **If you do not have a Go Outdoors Georgia account, you are required to enter your full Social Security Number below.** (While online, you can bypass using this application form by **completing a Customer Application to certify your disability!** Once approved by licensing personnel, you can purchase your disability licenses online or by calling 1-800-366-2661!) **If you cannot submit an online application, submit this paper application & attachments to: LBRU–Disability, 2065 US Hwy. 278 SE, Social Circle, GA 30025**

For Sportsman's or Hunting Disability License purchases, Hunter Education is required if born after Jan. 1, 1961. This must be documented in your Go Outdoors Georgia account at <https://www.gooutdoorsgeorgia.com/> before purchase.

Step 3. RESIDENCY VERIFICATION

Residency is defined as being domiciled within Georgia for a period of at least three (3) months prior to applying for a license and in possession of a permanent GA driver's license or official GA ID card. A person may be a resident of only one state.

****Critical:** Attach a photocopy of one of the following valid documents. GA Driver's License or State of GA ID Card.

Step 4. CHOOSE DISCOUNTED DISABILITY LICENSE TYPE AND PAYMENT TYPE

NOTE: Disability Licenses are valid for either three (3) years or one (1) year from date of issue. They may be renewed within 90 days of expiration. Per O.C.G.A. §27-2-4, persons disabled because of mental impairment are eligible for honorary fishing license only.

STEP 5. AGENCY CERTIFICATION AND DOCUMENTATION

Proper documentation must be attached to the application. **Photocopies of the referenced documents must be attached – forms will not be returned.** Documentation from agencies vary in form, but, in general, documentation should contain the following elements:

1. The Social Security Administration – you are disabled and receiving disability benefits.
2. The Department of Veterans Affairs – you have a 100% disability rating or permanent and total disability.
3. The Railroad Retirement Board (**but only for Disability Retirements**).
4. Medicaid or Medicare – you are permanently and totally disabled.
5. Physician's Certification of Total Blindness (Lifetime Honorary Blind Fishing License).

Check below for the agency that certified you as totally and permanently disabled and from which you are receiving disability benefits.

1. ___ Social Security Administration

A. Submit a Notice of Award Letter OR,

B. Submit a Benefit Verification Letter (BVL)

a. The BVL must include the type of benefit. For example, the letter should state **“monthly disability benefits.”**

b. The BVL is available from SSA online, at the phone number below, and from a local SSA office but only upon requesting a BVL that includes the type of benefit.

- **Social Security Online:** Go to www.ssa.gov, and click on My Social Security. Either create an account, or sign into your account. Once in your account, you will see an option to print a BVL letter.
- **Social Security Office:** call 1-800-772-1213 for assistance.

(DO NOT SUBMIT: SSA 1099 Form, Notice of Decision-Fully Favorable letter, and Yearly Income Statements from Social Security – these are not acceptable documentation.)

2. ___ United States Department of Veterans Affairs (100% disability rating or permanently and totally disabled).

- **A photocopy of your Benefit Summary and Service Verification Letter may be obtained through the following methods:**
 - **Veteran's Office Online (immediate Letter download):** Go to <https://www.va.gov/records/download-va-letters/>. Sign in or create account, then select “Get your VA Benefit Letters”, select “Download Benefit Summary and Service Verification Letter (PDF)”.
 - **Veteran's Office Phone Request (not immediate):** 1-800-827-1000, listen to the options and select the “Letters” option and follow the instructions to have Benefit Summary and Service Verification Letter faxed or mailed to you.
- **A photocopy of the Identification and Privilege Card stating 100% Disabled American Veteran INDEF**

3. ___ Railroad Retirement Board (Disability Retirements Only). **Letter or documentation of total and permanent disability.**

4. ___ Medicare or Medicaid. **Letter or documentation of total and permanent disability.**

5. ___ Physician's Certification of Total Blindness (Lifetime Honorary Blind Fishing License). **Document must state that you are totally blind with no light perception (NLP).**

In very rare cases, your private physician may certify your disability. Such cases are limited to the following situations only: You have never worked in a job covered by any of the above referenced agencies or did not work long enough to receive disability benefits from such an agency. (Note: documentation must include a copy of the rejection letter from the Social Security Administration Office).

NOTE: Your Disability License is a full privilege Sportsman License, unless it is designated “FISHING ONLY”. The only other licenses you may need in addition to the Disability License are a no-charge SIP permit for fishing in salt water, a no-charge Harvest Record for hunting deer, bear and turkey, a no-charge Georgia Migratory Bird Stamp to hunt migratory birds, and/or a Federal Duck Stamp for hunting waterfowl. These licenses and stamps are available online and anywhere Georgia licenses are sold.
