## **Permit Application Procedures for Tournament "Live-Release" Boat(s)**

Any waterborne vessel carrying fish to locations on a lake or river and releasing them away from a tournament weigh-in area should be considered a "Live-Release" vessel. As long as this vessel does not carry a quantity of fish that exceeds the possession limit of the persons on-board, this is not a problem. Carrying numbers of fish in excess of the possession limit puts the vessel's occupants in violation of the law without express permission from the Department of Natural Resources in the form of a contract or permit.

Procedures to obtain a "Live-Release" vessel permit (no fee required) are as follows:

- 1. Download and print the permit application or call 770-761-3011/3014 to request one to be mailed.
- 2. Complete the application, sign and return to:

Applications should be **received at least 30 days prior to the start of the proposed tournament**. Remember to also submit a copy of the tournament rules and angler entry form with your application.

Incomplete applications will be returned if sufficient time exists for re-submission prior to a scheduled tournament. No application will not be considered less than 6 business days prior to a tournament.

Applications will be reviewed to determine suitability of your vessel(s) as a "Live-Release" platform based on the information provided. Once approved, your permit and will be mailed to the "Applicant Address" listed on the application. A copy of the "Live-Release" permit should be maintained on-board each vessel transporting and restocking tournament fish.
