For your enjoyment and in consideration of others please observe the following while visiting us:

- ➔ A \$5 daily parking permit must be purchased upon arrival and displayed on each vehicle (including RV's) pursuant to Law Code 27.4-11.1. A \$30 annual pass is also available, but must be displayed while parking on the area. For registered campers, one daily parking permit is valid for the complete length of their stay. Visitors must also purchase and display a parking permit each day the campground is visited.
- ➔ IT IS UNLAWFUL TO POSSESS OR TO BE UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL OR DRUGS WHILE ON THIS AREA.
- ➔ Campers must register and pay for campsites within 30 minutes of setting up camp and before campground closing time of 10:00 p.m. The registration envelope must be filled out completely at the time of registration and contain full payment for the indicated length of stay.
- ➔ All camping in the general public camping area is on a first-come basis, NO RESERVATIONS OR RESERVING OF SITES PERMITTED. A tent, camper, or vehicle must be on the site within two hours of registration, after two hours your site will be forfeited with no refunds. Failure to pay for an occupied site will result in all personal equipment/supplies being removed from the site at the owner's expense.
- ➔ No re-entry to the campground after campground closing at 10:00 p.m.
- ➔ All fishing and boating activities are prohibited daily from sunset to sunrise (See Fishing/Boating Guide for more information).
- ➔ Camping may only occur at developed, designated campsites.
- ➔ Please obey all traffic rules and signs in the campground. Vehicular traffic in the campground is **one way, counter-clockwise only**. The roads are not built for two-way traffic.
- ➔ Campers must display a camping registration receipt on the post provided at each campsite.
- ➔ Only campers may remain on the area from 10:00 p.m. until sunrise; however, all persons are restricted to the camping area from one hour after sunset to one hour before sunrise.
- ➔ Any activity that disturbs other campers between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. is prohibited. Please limit your activities to your campsite during nighttime hours.
- ➔ Registered campers must check out by 12:00 p.m. on the day of their departure or pay for another night stay.
- ➔ Occupancy of campsites is limited to fourteen (14) consecutive days during the period of March 1st to October 31st. Any camper who has used a campsite for fourteen consecutive days during these dates must vacate the camping area for a period of not less than four (4) days before again occupying a campsite. For the period of **November 1st through the end of February**, campers may stay in the designated extended stay camp sites at a monthly rate of \$375 per month, rate is based on 30 days and must be paid up front to receive the discount. After 30 days, the camper may stay at half the daily rate for the rest of their stay but must be paid at least a week in advance.
- ➔ Visitors to campsites are welcome, however, visitors are required to leave prior to the campground closing time of 10:00 p.m.

- ➔ Dishwashing is prohibited at drinking faucets and at comfort station.

- ➔ It is unlawful to block any gate or drive around any sign or device that designates a closed road.
- ➔ The beach closes to all public use at posted times. Swimming is only allowed at the beach and only during posted times.
- ➔ Littering is unlawful. Please take your trash with you or dispose of it in the receptacles provided.
- ➔ The playground closes to all public use at dark.
- ➔ Campers may cut only dead and fallen trees for firewood to be used on the area.
- ➔ Campers launching boats must keep all vehicles and trailers at their campsite or in designated campground parking areas from sunset to sunrise.
- ➔ Pets are allowed on the area and in campgrounds if kept on a leash no longer than six (6) feet or otherwise confined and accompanied by and under the direct control of their owner at all times. Owners are responsible for the conduct of their pets, and must clean up after them. Pets are NOT ALLOWED in restrooms, comfort stations, bathhouse, on the beach, or in the swimming area. All pets must be kept on a leash and under the direct control of a reasonable adult. The person responsible for a pet must clean up after their pet while anywhere on Rocky Mountain Recreation and Public Fishing Area.
- ➔ Campers under 18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult while other users under 14 years of age must be accompanied by an adult while on the area. For their safety, please limit your children's activities to your campsite during the hours of darkness.
- ➔ **Additional sites must be rented when any of the following limits is reached.** Designated "double campsites" are double the indicated amounts. Each campsite is limited to one immediate family of six (6) people. Two (2) tents and a boat are allowed at each campsite plus one of the following applicable vehicle occupancy combinations:
 - 1) One motor home and one automobile;
 - 2) One automobile with pop-up trailer (or other type of tent) and one additional automobile;
 - 3) One automobile with travel trailer and one additional automobile;
 - 4) One pickup truck with mounted camping rig and one additional automobile; or,
 - 5) Two motorized vehicles.
- ➔ Visitor vehicles do not count towards campsite occupancy limits unless they are overnight guests in which their vehicle will count toward campsite limits **but must also purchase a parking permit.**
- ➔ Parking for the beach or other non-campground activity is not allowed in the campground for anyone other than registered campers.
- ➔ All vehicles and trailers of registered campers and their guest must park in such a manner as not to impede the normal flow of traffic or not to damage campsite facilities or natural features.
- ➔ Emergency 911 phones are located at the campground comfort station and in the breezeway of the beach bathhouse.
- ➔ Campsite Housekeeping; Campers are expected to keep their campsite picked up and in order. Prohibited items and activities include: no fences or obstructions that would restrict maintenance of the area by staff, no storage sheds or boxes placed on site, no items that will damage trees (lanterns hanging on trees, no nails in trees)
