

# Proposed Hunting Regulations 2025-2027 Seasons

#### Why are we here?

The General Assembly declares that the state's wildlife resources shall be managed in accordance with sound principles of wildlife management, using all appropriate tools, including hunting, fishing, and the taking of wildlife (OCGA 27-1-3).

The purpose of these public meetings is to:

- 1) Encourage public participation;
- 2) Obtain input for consideration; and
- 3) Exchange information.

Jan - Public Input

Feb - Develop Proposals


Mar- Review by DNR Board

Apr - Public Notice & Hearings

May- DNR Board Action

Jun - Develop Popular Guide

July- Distribution to Public



# Regulatory Objectives

- 1. Biologically Appropriate & Scientifically Sound
- 2. Responsive to Public Desires within Biological Appropriateness
- Strive for Simplicity & Flexibility
  - Minimize challenges for Recruitment, Retention & Reactivation (R<sup>3</sup>)

#### Major Changes – Legislation

- Rules governing hunting and fishing are either statutory (state law) or regulatory. State laws are passed by the legislature.
  Regulations are passed by the Board of Natural Resources within statutory authority.
- No bills were passed last session that significantly impact hunting
  - HB 927 Hunter pink did not pass

# Proposed Changes – Statewide Regulations

• Currently, WRD has only 1 hunting regulation change that impacts the entire state. The US Fish and Wildlife Service has shortened the early teal season by 6 days due to declines in the blue-winged teal population. The opening date and bag limits will remain the same.

• 9 day teal season: Sept 13 - 21, 2025
