These sites are open to the public and offer specific amenities for anglers with disabilities.

Amicalola Creek	Dawson County, off Hwy. 53	Fishing piers	From Dawsonville, go west on Hwy. 53 for 6 miles. Turn right just before crossing bridge.	Stocked monthly late March through mid-May, then twice monthly through Labor Day. <i>This portion of Amicalola Creek is catch and release only from 11/1 through 5/14.</i>
Chattahoochee River	Gwinnett County, Don White Memorial Park	Fishing pier	From Hwy. 400, go east on Holcomb Bridge Road for .1 mile, turn right onto Market Way for .3 miles and then right on Old Alabama Road for .5 miles and right again onto Riverside Rd. Park is underneath Hwy. 400 bridge.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Chattahoochee River	Cobb County, Cochran Shoals Unit of the Chattahoochee River National Recreation Area	Fishing piers	From I-285 West, take Exit 22, Northside Drive, New Northside Drive, Powers Ferry Rd. and turn right on New Northside Drive. Use "through" lane to pick up Interstate North Parkway. Park is .8 miles on the right after crossing the river.	Stocked from November 1 through mid-April. <i>This portion of the Chattahoochee River is catch and release only from 11/1 through 5/14.</i>
Dockery Lake	Lumpkin County, near Woody Gap	Fishing pier	From Dahlonega go north on Hwy. 60 for 12 miles, turn right on Forest Service Road 654 for 1 mile.	Stocked 6 times during the March to Memorial Day period.
Etowah River	Lumpkin County, near U.S. Army Camp Frank D. Merrill	Fishing platform	From Dahlonega, go north on Hwy. 19 for 2.3 miles. Turn left onto Camp Wahsega Rd. Go 8 miles, then left on Hightower Church Rd. for 1.5 miles. Turn right at bridge.	Stocked weekly, late March through July 4th, and twice monthly through Labor Day
Holly Creek	Murray County, near Chatsworth	Fishing platform	From Eton, go east on Old CC Camp Rd for 6.3 miles. Parking area on left.	Stocked twice monthly late March through Labor Day
Johns Creek	Floyd County, near Villanow	Fishing platform	From Villanow, go east on Hwy. 136 for .3 miles and turn right on Pocket Rd. Go south 8 miles. Parking area on right.	Stocked twice monthly late March through Labor Day.
Little Amicalola Creek	Dawson County, Amicalola Falls State Park	Fishing platform	From Dawsonville, go east on Hwy. 53 for 3 miles. Turn right on Hwy. 183 for 8 miles, then left on Hwy. 52 for 4 miles. Park entrance on right.	Stocked twice monthly late March through Labor Day.
Moccasin Creek	Rabun County, Moccasin Creek State Park	Fishing piers	From Clarkesville, go north on Hwy. 197 for 18 miles. Park entrance on right.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Rock Creek	Fannin County, Chattahoochee Forest National Fish Hatchery	Fishing platforms	From Blue Ridge, go east on Hwy. 76 for 5 miles to Morganton and turn right on Hwy. 60. Go south for 14 miles, then right on Rock Creek Rd. for 5 miles. Hatchery is on the right.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Smith Creek	White County, Unicoi State Park	Fishing platforms	From Robertstown, go east on Hwy. 356 for 1.5 miles. Turn left on Anna Ruby Falls Rd.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Tallulah River	Tallulah River above Lake Burton in Rabun County	Fishing pier	Take U.S. 76 west from Clayton for 8 miles; turn right (north) Persimmon Rd. (a paved county road) for 5 miles; turn left (northwest) on Tallulah River Road for 1 mile to Tallulah River fishing pier on left.	Weekly, Late March through Labor Day
Toccoa River	Fannin County, USFS Deep Hole Recreation Area	Fishing pier	From Blue Ridge, take Hwy. 76 east for 5 miles to Morganton. Turn right on Hwy. 60 and go south for 16 miles. Turn right onto recreation area access road.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Vogel Lake	Union County, Vogel State Park	Fishing platforms	From Blairsville, go 11 miles south on Hwy. 19/129. Turn right into Park.	Stocked 6 times from March through Memorial Day

Chattahoochee River	Forsyth County, Buford Dam, Lower Pool Park	Bank access at U.S. Army Corps of Engineers park	From Hwy. 400, turn onto Buford Dam Rd., go 4.5 miles and turn right. Follow access road to park.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Chattahoochee River	Fulton and Gwinnett County, Jones Bridge parks	Bank access at U.S. Army Corps of Engineers park	From GA 400 North, take Exit 7A, Holcomb Bridge/Norcross 140 East. Go 4.1 miles and turn left onto Barnwell Rd. In 1.6 miles, turn right into Jones Bridge unit.	Weekly, early March through Labor Day, stocked once monthly from September through December
Chattahoochee River	White County, Helen area	Numerous bank access points inside the city limits of Helen and alongside Poplar Stump Rd.	In Helen, and north of town on Hwy. 75. Turn left onto 75 Alt., then right on Poplar Stump Road. Look for management area boundary signs.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Cooper Creek	Union County, off Hwy. 60 near Suches	Bridge and bank access on maintained USFS Road	In Suches, turn onto Hwy. 180 (Wolf Pen Gap Rd.). Go 4 miles and turn left onto Cooper Creek Rd. Look for management area boundary signs.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Dicks Creek	Lumpkin County, off Hwy. 19 near Turners Corner	Bank access on maintained USFS Road	From Cleveland go 8 miles north on Hwy. 19/129 to Turner's Corner. Turn left onto Hwy. 19, go .1 mile, turn right onto Dicks Creek Rd. for 4 miles. Look for Chestatee WMA boundary sign.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day.
Low Gap Creek	White County, Chattahoochee WMA, near Helen	Access from bank and around bridge on maintained USFS Road	From Helen, go north on Hwy. 75 for 2 miles. Turn left onto 75 Alt., then right on Poplar Stump Road. Go 7 miles to Low Gap Creek campground.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Panther Creek, Habersham County	Habersham County, near Hollywood	Bank Access inside USFS day-use area	From Hollywood, go north on Historic Old Hwy. 441 for 8 miles. Turn left into Panther Creek Day Use Area.	Stocked twice monthly from late March through Labor Day
Panther Creek, Stephens County	Stephens County, near Lake Yonah Dam.	Bank access on county maintained road	From Toccoa go north on Hwy. 184 (Prather Br. Rd.) for 6 miles, turn left on Yonah Dam Road for 6 miles, then left onto dirt road and follow creek.	Weekly, late March through July 4th.
Tallulah River	Rabun and Towns County, near Clayton	Access from bank and around bridges on county-maintained road	From Clayton, take Hwy. 76 W. for 8 miles. Turn right at Tallulah- Persimmon Fire Station. Go 4 miles, turn left on Tallulah River Rd. Go 1.5 miles to Tallulah River Campground (USFS). Public access begins here.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
Toccoa River	Fannin County, near McCaysville, Horseshoe Bend Park	Bank access inside county park	From McCaysville, go east on Hwy 60 for 0.7 mile. Turn right on River Road for 1 mile to Horseshoe Bend Park on right.	Stocked weekly from late March through July 4th, twice monthly through Labor Day
Warwoman Creek	Rabun County, near Clayton	Access from bank and around bridge on county-maintained road	From Clayton, go east on Warwoman Road for 8 miles. Turn right on Earl's Ford Road and go .8 miles.	Weekly, late March through Labor Day
