GENERAL RULES AND REQUIREMENTS

The PFA Record Program runs from January 1–December 31. Applications must be received no later than January 15 of the year following the catch.

RECOGNITION & REWARDS: Awards are annual for the appropriate year: a certificate (for each qualifying fish), a t-shirt (limit—1), personalized ball cap (limit—1 per qualifying catch; no more than 3 caps total regardless of number of qualifying catches. Angler can choose fish for hats or WRD will select if no preference given). Rewards are sent at end of the calendar year (or closely after). Names and photos of Award recipients may be posted on the WRD website, and may be used in social media posts, or released to media or other interested parties.

Who Can Apply? All properly licensed anglers, resident or non-resident are eligible. WRD reserves the right to refuse any questionable entry.

Legal Season, Sporting Tackle & Other Information: Fish must be caught in Georgia during the legal angling season for the species taken in accordance with all fishing laws and regulations. Fish must be caught on sporting tackle and be hooked and landed by the entrant. Bush hooks, trot lines, jugs, baskets, nets, etc., are not considered sporting tackle. Fish caught from hatcheries or intensive fish culture facilities are not eligible. Freshwater fish caught from private waters in which adults of the species in question are stocked are not eligible. No frozen or mounted fish are eligible.

Certified Scale: Fish must be weighed on a scale that has been certified accurate to the nearest ounce, or lesser weight, by the Department of Agriculture within the last year. Fish may be weighed in pounds and ounces or in metric; however, metric weights will be converted to pounds and ounces. Estimated weights will not be accepted. The weight of the sling, platform, or rope (if one is used when weighing the fish) must be deducted from the total weight. Only one-ounce graduation will be recognized. Visual fractionizing of graduations is not allowed. Weights that fall between two graduations of the scale must be rounded to the lower of the two. The owner of the scale must provide an address and telephone number.

Application & Photos: The angler must submit an application form with a clear, side view photo of the fish, and a photo of the angler with the fish. Submit application in one of the following ways:

OFFICIAL RULES: Public Fishing Area Record Program

PFA Record Awards are awarded for kept fish that are the largest of each species caught and properly documented at each PFA. Review the following information before applying:

PUBLIC FISHING AREA RECORD FISH RULES:

Time Frame: Applications must be submitted within 7 days of the catch.

Qualifying Weight: The fish must weigh at least two ounces more than the existing record to be a new record (see next page). If there is no existing record, fish must meet the **Angler Award minimum size** to qualify as a PFA record. (see previous page)

Eligible species: PFA records will be recognized for Largemouth Bass, Black or White Crappie, Bluegill, Redear Sunfish, and Channel Catfish.

Identification: A WRD Fisheries Section biologist or technician must identify the fish either in person, or be able to clearly identify the fish species and where it was caught from photos or video, and sign the application.

Certified Scale: PFA Record Fish must be weighed on a certified scale (see info to left for more information on certified scales).

Witnesses: Fish must be weighed in the presence of two witnesses, both of whom must be at least 18 years old and not a member of the entrant's immediate family. Both witnesses must provide an address and telephone number on the application. Witnesses are not necessary if the fish is weighed on a certified scale at a WRD office or PFA in the presence of WRD personnel.
